## 2018-2019 School Profile

### Affiliations:

Legacy Christian Academy is chartered by the State of Ohio Department of Education and accredited by both the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and AdvancED.

### School History and Description:

Legacy Christian Academy, formerly Xenia Christian School, was founded in 1967, as Xenia Christian Day School, with its first class graduating in 1983. In 1993, the school became part of the Dayton Christian School System and the name was changed to Xenia Christian School. In 2016, Xenia Christian School once again became independent from DCSS and the name was changed to Legacy Christian Academy. In 1999, the school moved to its current location on the site of the former Ohio Soldiers' and Sailors' Orphanage. The property is shared with various ministries including Athletes in Action, Heart to Honduras, International School Project, and others. The property includes state of the art athletic fields which are shared with AIA. Xenia is a residential suburb of Dayton, OH with a mixture of suburban, rural and military families. It is a city of approximately 25,000 and is the county seat of Greene County.

Legacy Christian Academy is a private, non-denominational Christian School. We use traditional curriculum, have a college preparatory emphasis, and serve families from Greene and surrounding counties. We also welcome several international students to our student body.
