

2026–2027 SCHOOL DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP PROCESS

Legacy Christian Academy shares campus roads with several neighboring organizations, including AIA, Strong Tower Radio, Samaritan's Purse, Jerusalem University, and Legacy Village. Due to our increasing enrollment, we are adjusting our carline route and parking patterns this year to lessen the impact on our campus neighbors while providing a safe and efficient process for our families.

The elementary parent carline will be on Douglas Lane, the road that runs between the Barnett and Lincoln buildings. Elementary drop-off (7:45 a.m. Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday; 8:25 a.m. Wednesday) and pick-up (2:45 p.m.) will take place in the designated area of the employee parking lot behind Lincoln, located at the end of Douglas Lane near the LCA playground.

Middle and high school student pick-up will take place in the parking spaces along Wesley Avenue in front of the Auditorium, Lincoln, and Barnett buildings. To help keep traffic moving, please do not enter Douglas Lane unless you are dropping off or picking up an elementary student.

Please note that the Lake Street entrance gate will be closed during morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up. All vehicles should enter and exit campus via Home Road or Union Road.

Please Note: The student and employee parking lots are permit parking only from **7:15 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.** Please do not park in these lots during the school day or during drop-off and pick-up.

EARLY ROOM/DROP-OFF PROCEDURES

All students—elementary, middle, and high school—arriving before **7:45 a.m.** (or **8:25 a.m. on Wednesdays**) should report to the LCA Cafeteria Early Room. Early Room drop-off takes place in front of the LCA Auditorium. Students may enter through the Auditorium entrance beginning at **7:15 a.m.**

After 7:45 a.m. (8:25 a.m. on Wednesdays)

Parents dropping off elementary students only

- Join the elementary carline.
- Please allow your child(ren) to walk into school independently. Families will have an opportunity to practice this process during Knights' Night on August 10. Establishing this routine at the beginning of the school year is an important step toward developing confidence and independence in our youngest students. We will be there to help every step of the way!

Parents dropping off both elementary and middle/high school students

- Join the elementary carline and drop off all students in the employee parking lot behind Lincoln.

Parents dropping off middle/high school students only

- Drop off students anywhere in front of the LCA Gym, Auditorium, Lincoln, or Barnett buildings.

PICK-UP PROCEDURES

Parents picking up elementary students only

- Join the elementary carline during your assigned pick-up window. The color of your pick-up tag corresponds to your designated dismissal time.

Parents picking up both elementary and middle/high school students

- Please instruct your older student(s) to wait with their elementary sibling(s) at the end of the elementary carline. Pick-up should occur after **3:05 p.m.**, according to your assigned pick-up window.

Parents picking up middle/high school students only

- Please meet your student(s) in front of the Gym, Auditorium, Lincoln, or Barnett buildings.
