

Head Varsity Coach:

An LCA varsity head coach is called to train and equip leaders for Christ within his or her team and other interactions with the LCA student body, contributing positively toward the spiritual, academic, and personal development of each student athlete. Additionally, an LCA varsity head coach will be responsible for the overall leadership of their sport's program, encompassing varsity, junior varsity, junior high, and elementary programs that exist for their sport. LCA is a member of the Metro Buckeye Conference and OHSAA. As such, an LCA varsity head coach is responsible for following the bylaws of OHSAA and of the Metro Buckeye Conference.

Requirements:

- Full support for LCA's mission, vision, philosophy, core values, and statement of faith
- Passion for building relationships with student athletes, parents, coaches, and other LCA employees in a Christian environment with the mission of *Equipping Leaders for Christ*
- A clear desire and ability to coach in a biblically-integrated, Christian manner
- Demonstrated strong communication, organization, and leadership skills
- Coaching team orientation
- Patient and flexible while leading toward student athlete and team success
- Knowledge and understanding of the OHSAA and Metro Buckeye bylaws
- Clear knowledge of and ability to coach the sport at a varsity level
- Previous coaching experience

Prior to Season Requirements (annually):

- Current required certifications
- Current Ohio Pupil Activity Permit (PAP)

Ideal Qualifications:

- Previous head coaching experience, particularly varsity head coaching experience
- Previous playing experience in the sport at the varsity level or beyond
