



Junior High Head Coach:

An LCA junior high head coach is called to train and equip leaders for Christ within his or her team and other interactions with the LCA student body, contributing positively toward the spiritual, academic, and personal development of each student athlete. In cooperation with the head varsity coach's leadership of the overall sport's program, an LCA junior high head coach is responsible for the leadership of the junior high team. LCA is a member of the Metro Buckeye Conference. As such, an LCA junior high head coach is responsible for following the bylaws of the Metro Buckeye Conference.

Requirements:

- Full support for LCA's mission, vision, philosophy, core values, and statement of faith
- Passion for building relationships with student athletes, parents, coaches, and other LCA employees in a Christian environment with the mission of *Equipping Leaders for Christ*
- A clear desire and ability to coach in a biblically-integrated, Christian manner
- Demonstrated strong communication, organization, and leadership skills
- Coaching team orientation
- Patient and flexible while leading toward student athlete and team success
- Knowledge and understanding of the Metro Buckeye bylaws
- Clear knowledge of and ability to coach the sport at a junior high level
- Previous coaching experience

Prior to Season Requirements (annually):

- Current required certifications
- Current Ohio Pupil Activity Permit (PAP)

Ideal Qualifications:

- Previous head coaching experience
- Previous playing experience in the sport
