Legacy Christian Academy is chartered by the State of Ohio Department of Education and accredited by both the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and Cognia.

### School History and Description:

Legacy Christian Academy, formerly Xenia Christian School, was founded in 1967, as Xenia Christian Day School, with its first class graduating in 1983. In 1993, the school became part of the Dayton Christian School System and the name was changed to Xenia Christian School. In 2016, Xenia Christian School once again became independent from DCSS and the name was changed to Legacy Christian Academy. In 1999, the school moved to its current location on the site of the former Ohio Soldiers' and Sailors' Orphanage. The property is shared with various ministries including Athletes in Action, a Christian radio station, WFCJ, and senior housing, Legacy Village and Assisted Living. The property includes state of the art athletic fields which are shared with AIA. Xenia is a residential suburb of Dayton, OH with a mixture of suburban, rural and military families. It is a city of approximately 27,000 and is the county seat of Greene County.

Legacy Christian Academy is a private, non-denominational Christian School. We use traditional curriculum, have a college preparatory emphasis, and serve families from Greene and surrounding counties. We also welcome several international students to our student body.

### College Level / College Credit Dual Enrollment

Beginning with the 2015-2016 school year, many of our students chose to pursue college credit through the State of Ohio's College Credit Plus program. As a result, we suspended our AP® offerings. We have since brought back our AP® program. Students continue to have access to advanced coursework through colleges such as Cedarville University, Wright State University, Clark State Community College, and Sinclair Community College, earning college credit and experience. Our students can take several classes for Cedarville University credit within our classrooms. Students not receiving the college credit take the same course and earn a college level (CL) weighted GPA bump.
