

## **Vaccination:**

Legacy is not requiring vaccination. However, please be aware that recent CDC guidance for COVID-19 prevention in K-12 schools (July 9, 2021, CDC guidance) describes vaccination for eligible individuals (12 years old and up) as “the leading public health prevention strategy to end the COVID-19 pandemic.”

## **Face Coverings:**

Face coverings will not be required at LCA at the current time. However, please be aware that the CDC currently recommends that individuals who are not fully vaccinated should wear a mask while indoors at school, and the American Academy of Pediatrics (July 18, 2021 AAP Update) recommends that “all students older than 2 years and all school staff should wear face masks at school (unless medical or developmental conditions prohibit use).” Students and staff who wish to wear face coverings at LCA will be permitted, but not required, to do so.

## **Handwashing:**

Students, staff, and visitors are encouraged to frequently and thoroughly wash hands or disinfect them.

## **Staying Home when Sick:**

For the health of our community, it is important that students showing symptoms of illness must not attend school. Thank you for helping us reduce the spread of illness in our school community.

## **Cleaning/Sanitization:**

Legacy will continue regularly cleaning and sanitizing high-touch and classroom surfaces.

## **Quarantine:**

Legacy will cooperate with the Greene County Health Department regarding quarantine expectations for confirmed COVID cases and/or exposure.
