PRESCHOOL

Monday - Thursday

Jeans, pants, or shorts (Modest length. If a child wears leggings, they must be worn with a tunic top or a dress.)

Shirts (no tank tops, halter tops, or shirts with offensive writing/pictures)

Skorts; skirts or dresses (with shorts, tights, or leggings underneath)

Tennis shoes (Velcro) or closed-toe shoes (no flip-flops)

GRADES K - 6

Monday - Thursday

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| Shirts | Polo | LCA logo polo shirt in navy, light blue, gray, black, or white OR Any solid color polo shirt |
| | Turtleneck | Long-sleeved, solid color only |
| | Oxford | White, French blue, or light blue Button-down collar, or rounded collar (girls); long or short sleeve All but top two buttons must be buttoned |
| Pants | Pants | Khaki or navy chino (twill) |
| | Shorts | Khaki or navy chino (twill) |

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| Shirts | Polo | LCA academic logo polo shirt in navy, light blue, gray, black, or white |
| | Oxford | White, French blue, or light blue LCA academic logo shirt Button-down collar; long or short sleeve All but top two buttons must be buttoned |
| Pants/Shorts | | Khaki or navy chino (twill) |
| Skirt (girls) | | Khaki or navy twill, or uniform plaid Plain front or pleated |
| Sweaters | | Navy, gray, or black LCA academic logo sweater Uniform shirt must be worn under cardigan or zipper sweater |
| Sweatshirts | | LCA academic logo crewneck sweatshirt in navy, gray, or black |
| ¼ Zips | | LCA academic logo ¼ Zip - Dri-weave or fleece in navy, gray, or black |
| Shoes | | Closed-toe and heel shoes or boots |

| Socks/Tights | | Any color/variety |

GENERAL GUIDELINES K-12

for Regular and Spirit days as well as Special Events

1. Students are expected to dress according to uniform/dress code from the time they arrive on campus for school until they leave the campus for the day or begin practice or after-school activities.
2. All garments must have a traditional fit and be modest, neat, and clean.
3. Pants are to be worn at the waist – no sagging. No oversize, tight, or short styles. No cargo pockets.
4. Shorts inseam is to be at least 6" in grades K-6, at least 8" in grades 7-12. Skorts inseam(grades K-6) is to be at least 6".
5. Skirt length is to the top of the kneecap. Slits are acceptable in a straight skirt from the bottom of the hem/skirt up to the knee for walking ease.
6. Students in grades 7-12 must have LCA academic logos (shield & Legacy name) on all polos, oxfords, sweatshirts, ¼ zips, or sweaters worn on Monday-Thursday. Knights logos and team shirts may be worn on Fridays only.
7. Sweatshirts and ¼ zips may be worn with a t-shirt. (A student must have a polo if he/she takes off the sweatshirt or ¼ zip.)
8. T-shirts (long or short-sleeved) or turtleneck shirts may be worn under uniforms and can be any solid color, as long as there is not any writing showing. No thermal underwear may show. Tops must completely cover the midriff even when arms are raised.
9. Jackets, coats, hats, and other outer apparel must be removed in classrooms unless the principal permits students to wear them because of a cold building.
10. Jewelry should be in moderation and good taste. No visible tattoos or body piercing (except for girls' earrings). Boys are not to wear earrings at school or school functions.
11. Hairstyle extremes and non-traditional or unnatural hair colors are not permitted. Boys' hair must be off the collar, above the eyebrow, and with part of the ear showing. Boys are to be clean-shaven (no beards or mustaches).
