

FORMAL EVENT DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

For all attendees including their guests

Goal: Modesty, Formal Attire, Event Appropriate

NOTE: The intent of these guidelines is to ensure that everyone has a wonderful, memorable experience. The focus of the event should be on the social opportunity for every participant and the clothing that is worn should not be a distraction to that end. We have tried to be specific so that there is no question what the expectation of the guideline means. While shopping for appropriate clothing can be a challenge in this day and age, it can be a great learning opportunity. All participants, including guests from outside the school, must comply with these guidelines.

Ladies:

Neckline: Neckline should be high enough in the front so that no cleavage is visible,

including undergarments worn with the dress.

Dress Back: No low-cut or plunging back. A dress that maintains coverage on the sides and is

well above the natural waist is approved.

Dress Length: Dress/skirt length must be no shorter than the height of a standard size credit/gift

card $(3^{3/8}x \ 2^{1/8})$ standing on its short edge from the floor when the student is kneeling in the dress. Dress/skirt must touch the top of the credit card when worn

as intended.

Slip and/or sheer extensions are not considered part of the dress length.

Slits on the dress should not be higher than the length guideline above.

"High-low" dresses or scarf hem dresses must meet the length criteria above.

Dress Details: Dresses should not have any cutouts below the neckline or on the sides (lace,

netting/tulle, or other see-through materials are not acceptable to cover cut-outs). Flesh tone or form fitting underlays with see-through materials as overlays are not

acceptable. [Example: lace netting/tulle or see-through materials.]

Dresses should not be extremely tight-fitting, so they cling to the body.

Dresses must be one-piece.

Dresses must have visible straps on dress (no clear straps).

One-shoulder dresses which meet all other criteria are acceptable.

Halter dresses may be worn as long as they have appropriate neck and back lines.

Gentlemen:

Tuxedo, suit, sport coat, or vest.

Long pants (no shorts), shirt, tie, dress shoes (no tennis shoes).

Pants should fit properly on the hip and not sag below the waistline.

No earrings or visible tattoos.
