Summary:

An LCA assistant coach is called to train and *equip leaders for Christ* within his or her team and other interactions with the LCA student body. An LCA assistant coach will be responsible for assisting the head coach with the overall leadership of the program of their sport.

Position Requirements:

- Dynamic Christ-follower and Christian education driven
- Passion for building relationships with student athletes, parents, and other coaches in a Christian environment with the mission of equipping leaders for Christ
- Full support for LCA's mission, vision, philosophy, core values, and statement of faith
- Previous playing experience is required; coaching experience is preferred
- Clear knowledge of and ability to assist the head coach coaching the sport
- Strong communicator who is organized and has leadership skills
- Ability to follow instructions and to work as a member of a coaching team
- Knowledge of and understanding of the OHSAA and the Metro Buckeye Conference bylawas
- Have current OHSAA required certifications or ability to obtain them before the start of the season
- Have a current Pupil Activity Permit for coaches or ability to obtain one
